



**Resolution to Compensate Veterans for their Service**

*Passed by the Washtenaw County Democratic Party on January 20, 2019*

WHEREAS, From World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War, countless war veterans' service records since 1912 were destroyed by fire, etc. Thereby, the U.S. Army denied these veterans acknowledgement of their existence and services as a U.S. soldier as well as benefits owed to them and their survivors (especially veterans of color);

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the WC DP respectfully requests that our U.S. Congress and Senate create a task force to identify and rightfully compensate these forgotten soldiers/survivors what is rightfully owed to them.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be forwarded to the State Democratic Party with a recommendation for its acceptance and placement in the appropriate document or with appropriate committee for action and that this position of the MDP will remain in effect until which time it is replaced or repealed.
