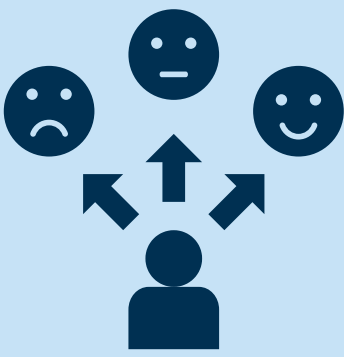




WHY VOTE "ABSENTEE"?

GIVE YOURSELF OPTIONS



When you vote absentee, you can choose to vote early -- by mail (by 10/13), **OR** in person at your clerk's office, **OR** by dropping your ballot in a secure drop box 24/7. **OR** you can go to your polling place on Election Day, "spoil" your absentee ballot, and vote in person there. **IT'S UP TO YOU!**
